

Cleveland Clinic Phlebotomy Technician

Phlebotomy Technicians are integral part of the medical laboratory team. Their primary function is to collect blood from patients and prepare the sample for testing. What are the Minimum Qualifications for Applicants?

In order to enroll in the Water Distribution Worker Apprenticeship Program, CMSD students:

- Must be 18 years of age by August 1st of the year enrolled;
- Must be a high school graduate or have obtained their GED;
- High school graduates must have an overall grade point average of 2.0;
- High school graduates must have an overall attendance rate of 90%; and
- High school graduates must have a letter of recommendation from an instructor or guidance counselor.

GED recipients may also apply as long as they are 21 years of age or younger, are within a 12month period from the date that the GED was received, and their last school of attendance was in the Cleveland Metropolitan School District.



Ohio Turnpike Commission's New Training Program Seeks Diverse Candidates for Maintenance Roadway Positions

The new program provides Commercial Driver's License (CDL) education and training at no cost to the trainee.

BEREA, Ohio (March 16, 2022) – The Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission has launched a new two-year apprentice program designed to increase diversity and inclusion among the ranks of its maintenance roadway workforce.

Eight apprenticeships (one per maintenance building) are available through the turnpike commission's first-ever <u>Maintenance Worker Class II Roadway Trainee</u> development program, which requires the trainees to sign a two-year agreement.

The entry-level program pays nearly \$23 per hour and provides Commercial Driver's License (CDL) education and training at no cost to the trainee. Other benefits include healthcare, pension, life insurance, paid leave and holidays, work boot stipend, and the potential for a full-time career with growth and advancement as a turnpike commission employee.

"The new diversity and inclusion program provides us with an opportunity to recruit talent from underrepresented groups, especially individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds," said Ferzan Ahmed, executive director of the turnpike commission. "The program will provide trainees with valuable skills and work experience in the highway maintenance field required to pursue a full-time career at the Ohio Turnpike or with another employer."

The trainee selection process will be based on the applicant's background, competency, demonstrated ability to learn the required skills, and aptitude to obtain a CDL within two years from their date of hire.

Trainees who are retained and complete the required duties may graduate from the program after completing the first year and would be eligible for permanent full-time Maintenance Worker Class II positions.

Applicants can select a preferred workplace location from the turnpike commission's eight maintenance buildings located in the Ohio cities of (west to east): Pioneer, Swanton, Elmore, Castalia, Amherst, Richfield, Windham and Canfield.

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



NON-TIPPED EMPLOYEES

A Minimum Wage of

\$9.30 per hour

"Non-Tipped Employees" includes any employee who does not engage in an occupation in which he/she customarily and regularly receives more than thirty dollars (\$30.00) per month in tips.

"Employers" who gross less than \$342,000 shall pay their employees no less than the current federal minimum wage rate.

"Employees" under the age of 16 shall be paid no less than the current federal minimum wage rate.

"Current Federal Minimum Wage" is \$7.25 per hour.

TIPPED EMPLOYEES

A Minimum Wage of \$4.65 per hour PLUS TIPS

"Tipped Employees" includes any employee who engages in an occupation in which he/she customarily and regularly receives more than thirty dollars (\$30.00) per month in tips. Employers electing to use the tip credit provision must be able to show that tipped employees receive at least the minimum wage when direct or cash wages and the tip credit amount are combined.
