

Women in Transition Scholarship Opportunity

The Women in Transition program is proud to offer a scholarship opportunity to participants who have completed and graduated the Women In Transition Program.

The WIT scholarship can only be utilized at Cuyahoga Community College; no other College, University, or Institution.

- The scholarship can be used for a degree program, certificate program, or workforce program at Tri-C
- The scholarship is applied directly to the student's account. If the student already paid for the class, the scholarship will pay for the class and the original form of payment will be returned to the student.
- A WIT scholarship is not renewable and typically covers the cost of one class.

To be considered for a WIT scholarship one must;

1. Be a graduate of the WIT Program
2. Submit confirmation of another scholarship application to WIT Interim Program Manager, Jazmyne Frost jazmyne.frost@tri-c.edu
3. Have a FAFSA on record at Tri-C for the academic year in question (You do not have to qualify for financial aid to receive a WIT scholarship, but you do have to have a FAFSA application on file with the college.)
4. Register for class(es). Yes, registration has to occur before one can be considered for a WIT scholarship.

Please note, WIT scholarship dollars can't be used for study abroad, but may be used for supplies.
