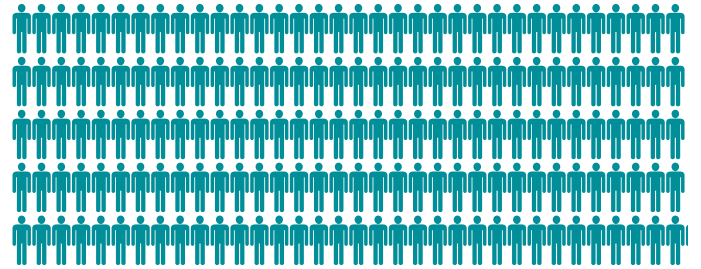

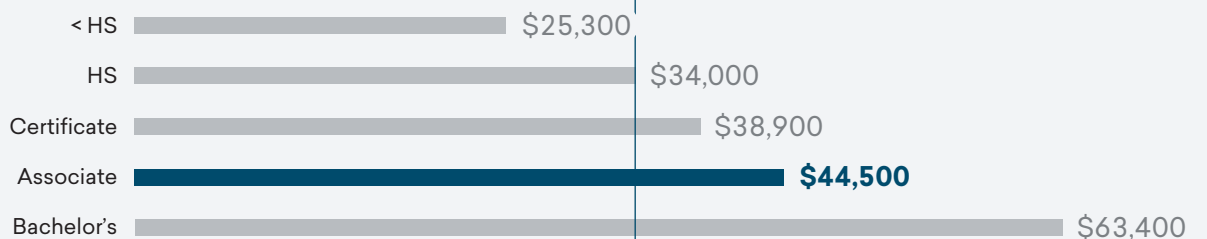

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS
