David is a tenured Counselor and Assistant Professor at Cuyahoga Community College in Parma, Ohio. Additionally, he taught Applied Psychology classes at the University of Akron from 1998-2014 and at Stark State College from 2005-2008. In addition to his Higher Education Experience, Mr. Nardecchia worked in community mental health from 1991-2007 as a Crisis Intervention Specialist. In addition to his daily duties, he also trains numerous Police Departments and Corrections Officers in Northeast Ohio about Suicide Prevention and Self Care. He has taken part in SWAT team debriefings and has trained Hostage Negotiation/Crisis Intervention Teams on Crisis Negotiation/Suicide Prevention Skills.

At Cuyahoga Community College, he currently serves in numerous capacities including: Co-Chair of the *Help Is Here* Suicide Prevention and Wellness Team which created a brand new website and mobile app; he was part of the initial implementation team of House Bill 28 that makes Suicide Prevention Education a requirement at all Ohio Colleges and Universities. The *Help Is Here* project was recently named *Innovation of the Year* by the League of Innovation in Higher Education. He also serves on the Opiate Task Force, Behavioral Intervention Team (BIT), is Crisis Team Leader (Mental Health), Co-Chairs the Mental Health Advisory Committee, Primary counseling contact for Veterans, New Student Orientation, Peer Mentoring and Site Counselor at the Brunswick University Campus.
